Tuition Payment Info

Reminder: We do not send bills for monthly tuition. Tuition is due the first class of the month. To insure that your check is properly credited into your account, it is VERY IMPORTANT that you write your dancers name and the month of tuition on your check before you drop it into the tuition box. If your child has a different last name than yours, it is especially important for their name to be on your check. A \$20 late fee will be added after the 15th of the month. NSF Checks will incur a \$20 fee. DO NOT PLACE CASH INTO THE TUITION BOX. Be sure to get a receipt from the front desk. If you have had class changes and are not sure of your tuition amount, check with the front desk. Please be sure that a Drop/Add form is filled out if you change, drop or add a class.

Direct Payment & Credit Card Payments

A direct payment plan is available for all of your tuition and costume payments. Payments are automatically deducted from your account on the 5th of each month through May 2016. Pick up the authorization form at the front desk to activate this convenient program. Be sure to inform the front desk of any changes to your bank account by the 1st of the month. Visa, MasterCard, Debit, and Discover card payments are also accepted with an additional charge of \$3 per transaction less than \$99, \$5 for transactions \$100 and over.

Recital Costume orders

The Spring Recital Costumes are ordered and paid for in November. Order forms are included with this newsletter and will be available at the front desk starting Monday, October 3rd. They are also available on our website www.danceworksmn.com. We order early to insure that we get the costumes we select and that they arrive in time for performances.

Lobby Rules Reminder

Please supervise your children while classes are in progress. If your child is disruptive, they will be asked to leave the facility. Dancers and small children are not allowed in the classrooms without an instructor.

Food and beverages, except for water, are not allowed in the lobbies or classrooms. We have several dancers that have high sensitivity to peanut products.

Please use the hooks for your coats & dance bags. It is a fire hazard to leave any type of clothing on the hall floors. Do not allow your dancer to wear their dance shoes outside. Street shoes are never allowed in the studios. The grit from the bottoms of the shoes damages the floors

Observation Etiquette

Parents please understand that you are always welcome to watch your dancer in class. However, please be sensitive as not to create a distraction for your dancer while watching through the windows. There is no videotaping or photos allowed of classes in session without the instructor's permission.

Please be respectful of these policies.

Parking Lot Protocol

The parking lot is designed for dropping off and drive through. Do not block the driveway entrance while waiting for your dancer at the end of their class, please pull forward all the way toward the fire hydrant in the 'Drop-off/Pick Up Only' lane.

Reminder

<u>Parents:</u> Please keep your child home if they are sick. The missed class may be "made up" by attending another when they are well.

All dancers must have their hair pulled back and secured for every class. Please pack hair bands for your dancer to use.

<u>Bathroom Breaks:</u> NO bathroom breaks will be allowed during class. We are concerned about students not washing hands sufficiently before returning to class. As an extra precaution there is hand sanitizer located in each classroom.

Sharing the Season

We will celebrate our annual production of Sharing the Season on Saturday December 10th, at 1 & 4pm at Lakeville South High School. The program will consist of Nutcracker choreography, along with a variety of music, song and dance. Save the **Date.** All competition tap dance groups. contemporary, competition kick classical ballet students Pink through Black will perform. Ballet rehearsals will be held on the 2nd Wednesday in October and November for ballet levels Blue - Black. All ballet levels will have a costume dress rehearsal on Saturday December 3rd from 10am - noon at DanceWorks.

Progressive Dance Classes

We still have openings in several of the progressive (non-competition) classes. Registration is open until October 31st.

Dads & Daughters Dance

All dancers who will be 10 by January 1st, 2017 or any of the competition dancers may participate in this dance with their dads. Sign up is required by November 18th to ensure enough time to process costume selections. An annual participation fee of \$225 per couple includes instruction time, daughters costume and accessories for dad. The form to participate in this class is available at the front desk. Class will begin Friday January 6th, 2017, 7:00 – 8:00 pm and will run until the spring recital. Melissa would like to take this dance to one competition, but please know that it is not mandatory to participate in it.
